## Custom Barn for Boatbuilding

Jim Irish has a desire to build a boat in the 30 x 48' barn that he is constructing in the backyard of his property on Lang Road in Rye. With the help of Kevin Knowlton from Knowltek Enterprises, a first-rate carpenter, his dream is well on its way. Jim looks to Kevin for his expertise as they work side-by-side. Project completion is any day now.

The barn is a large post and beam structure with a metal roof. The interior is massive and wide open. Jim purchased the materials from Rand Lumber Company. The lumber was milled in February and construction began in April. Rand supplied: 30' roof trusses, 1x10 rough boards, 2x4s, 2x6s, and 2x10s of rough hemlock, 1x10 shiplap and 1x6 V-joint for the doors.

Jim has used Rand for many other projects and doesn't hesitate to continue.

"Their service is outstanding," Jim says, "and they are very easy to work with."

Such a massive building will require a good source of heat in the cold New England winter months. He and Kevin have decided on a radiant heating system to be placed under the concrete floor. They both believe it will be the most efficient way to heat this amount of space.

When asked what kind of boat he hoped to be building inside, he mentioned a 36' Lobster/Sportfish boat, but was adamant that this boat project was still pending his wife's blessing.

Whatever Jim decides to do, this barn is shaping up to be a builder's dream.

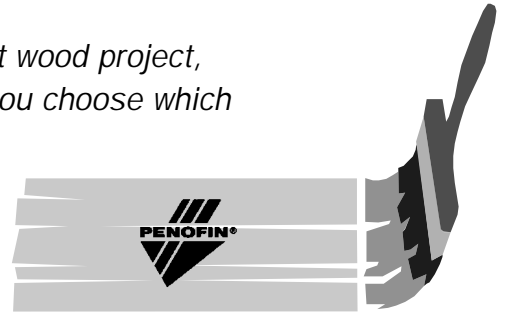

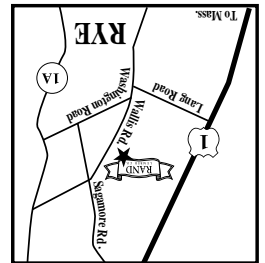
