Rand helps family update 200-year-old farmhouse



Roland and Kimberly Brewer have a family with growing needs. The couple has two young boys — Devin, 3, and 1-year-old Colin with another on the way in February. Such is the case, the Brewers' 200-year-old Rye farmhouse will have to grow with them, and they're counting on Rand Lumber for the materials and expertise to make it possible.

By day, Roland runs his own electronic component distribution company in Newington, but at night and on the weekends, he's the acting general contractor on his own project, enlisting the construction company Cedar Point as his crew. He previously worked with Rand when he built his own mahogany deck. Thoroughly impressed with both the materials and service he got on that project, he knew



exactly where to go when it came to rebuilding an entire section of his house.

"We demolished the existing one-car garage, workshop, laundry room, kitchen, breakfast nook and full bath and are replacing it with a much larger section that includes a three-car garage, laundry room, mud room, full bathroom, updated kitchen with breakfast nook and a new greatroom on top of the three car garage," Roland said.

The project was scheduled to be finished just in time to host Thanksgiving dinner. As of Nov. 17, Roland said everything was on-schedule, thanks in no small part to Jim Rand, co-owner of Rand Lumber.

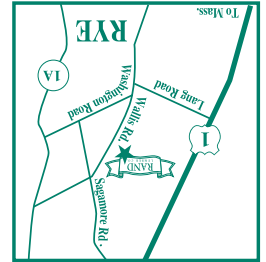
